

Cal State Sweepstakes Rules

Sanction Fees

Open Rabbit - \$15 per show

Open Cavy - \$10 per show

Specialty Breed Shows - \$10 per breed per show

Youth Rabbit - \$10 per show

Youth Cavy - \$10 per show

Cash awards will be given to the members who place in the top standings of each category (Open and Youth) during the Annual State Convention. The sweepstakes year runs from January 1 to December 31.

Who Participates In Sweepstakes Points: Only exhibitors who are members of Cal State will receive sweepstakes points.

How Points are Calculated: All of the points the exhibitor receives in a Cal State Sanctioned show are utilized to determine their accumulation of points for the Sweepstakes year. All of the rabbits or cavies that the exhibitor enters will be eligible for points. The point system will be the same as the ARBA uses. As outlined in ARBA Show Rules points are calculated as follows: First prize counts as six (6); second, four (4); third, three (3); fourth, two (2); and fifth, one (1). The number of points won by an animal in a class is calculated by multiplying the number of animals exhibited and judged in the class by the number identified above. For example, for ten (10) animals in a class and the animal in question places second, then 10 times 4 equals 40 total points won by the animal.

How to Sanction a Show: Any California rabbit and/or cavy club may sanction their shows with Cal State. To sanction your rabbit and/or cavy show with Cal State complete the Cal State Sweepstakes Sanction Request form (available on the Cal State website at www.csrcba.com or from the Sweepstakes Chairperson) and forward it to the Sweepstakes Chairperson listed on the form. Include your check payable to Cal State Sweepstakes. This must be received by the Sweepstakes Chair before your show and it is recommended to do so at least 30 days before your show date as with breed sanctions.

Providing Reports to Cal State: It is the Show Secretary's responsibility to provide to Cal State a report showing the exhibitors and the points they accumulated during the show in total within 30 days of their show date. Some show programs will give you a list of the exhibitors' total points in the show. For example, the Show Program by the Gessweins has that list under Quick Reports, then under Display Points – Show. It will list the points in order of who got the most points to the least points, or you can list it in alphabetical order by name. The preferred report would be the **alphabetized order** for each show.
